Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.8 dated 15.02.2017 under Sections 130, 216, 212, 216-A, IPC, Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

The petitioner claims that he is in custody since 29.07.2018. In fact, the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender and thereafter arrested. Because of the fact that the petitioner was proclaimed offender, another FIR was registered in which he has arrested.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the investigation is complete and the challan has been presented. The precise allegation against the petitioner is to the effect that he gave shelter to the persons who had run away from the jail on 27.11.2016.

In the trial, charges have been framed and the prosecution propose to examine 23 witnesses but none has been examined. The

petitioner is not involved in any other case but for the FIR which has been noticed above. Still further, a Coordinate Bench had already released the petitioner-Gurvinder Singh @ Gori on regular bail in CRM-M No.1249 of 2018.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and for the detailed reasons recorded in CRM-M No.1249 of 2018, the petitioner is also directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Moga.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
