The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of criminal prosecution launched on the basis of FIR No.0006 dated 16.03.2017 registered under Sections 420/467/471 IPC at Police Station NRI, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that prosecution has already got recorded depositions of 6 prosecution witnesses out of total 12 prosecution witnesses.

Since trial of the case has already made substantial progress, therefore, the petitioner is relegated to the remedy before the learned trial court. However, the learned trial court is requested to conclude the proceedings within next four months.
