This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.201 dated 21.07.2018 registered under Sections 148/149/323/379-B/452/506 IPC at Police Station Khol District Rewari.

The allegations in the complaint were that the complainant was sleeping in his house when 15-20 people entered forcibly, gave beatings and took some valuables also. The complainant suffered five fractures.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

However, learned Asstt. Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ram Krishan has argued that the two arrested persons had disclosed that

the petitioner was the main accused. The location of the telephone of the

petitioner was also found at the same place at the time of occurrence. She further states that though the petitioner has appeared before the police but he is not disclosing the name of the other assailants and is not cooperating, the recoveries of the looted articles have also to be made.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
