The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 54 dated 24.02.2019 under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kheri Phul, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that a 'canter' with 50 metres of cable wire was found parked in his godown. It was alleged that the cable wire was alleged to have been stolen by the petitioner and he was looking for a customer to sell the same. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by order dated 10.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Shishpal, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 10.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
