This petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the petitioners on emergency parole for 4 weeks as the marriage of their sister namely Gunjan is going to be solemnized on 15/16.05.2019.

In this case notice was issued on 09.05.2019.

Today learned State counsel states that it has been verified that the marriage of the sister of the petitioners is indeed fixed but he points out that the petitioners have been convicted for 15 years in case FIR No.249 dated 08.06.2015 under Sections 15/25/27-A/29 & 31 of NDPS Act, 1985 and Sections 420/468/201 IPC, 1860 at P.S.Pehowa, District Kurukshetra and are a heavy flight risk and at the most they should be granted parole for the exact days on which the marriage has to take place and that too under police escort.

I find this to be a fair request. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to grant emergency parole to the petitioners from 15.05.2019 to 17.05.2019 under adequate police escort to attend the marriage of their sister.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.M. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
