Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 17.10.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh.

However, learned State counsel has opposed grant of interim bail to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is involved in one more case of similar nature whereas learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated along with other accused and he has been released on regular bail in that case.

Accordingly, interim order dated 17.10.2018 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner is directed to join investigation, if required by the Investigating Officer.
