The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88, dated 19.4.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148, 149, 326 of the IPC, at Police Station City Kapurthala.

As per the facts which have emerged, on 18.4.2019 some persons including the two sons of the petitioner had caused injuries to Amritpal Singh and Manjot. On the next day, the police received information that again a fight had broken out between both the parties at Kapurthala Civil Hospital and the present FIR was registered.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that actually after the FIR was lodged against the sons of the petitioner, he was called to the hospital to settle the matter and rather over there, he and the persons who had gone

with him suffered grievous injuries while no injury was reported on the other side and, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail in the present FIR.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from SI Onkar Singh, has accepted that there is medical record of serious injuries to the petitioner and the persons who had gone with him but there is no record of any injury to the party of Amritpal Singh etc.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
