Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.51 dated 02.09.2018, registered under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel submitted that compromise has been effected between the parties. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record photocopy of the statement of the prosecutrix which transpires that compromise has been effected in the Lok Adalat.

In this view of the matter, the interim order dated 17.10.2018, passed by this court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
