ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 21.04.2019, under Sections 452, 324 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' – for short) (Section 326 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that although petitioner No.1 was armed with a 'datar' but he had caught hold of the complainant. Petitioner No.2, who is a lady, is alleged to have raised only a 'lalkara'. The complainant has received only one injury, which is attributed to co-accused, namely, Amandeep Singh alias Goldy for which offence under Section 326 IPC has been added. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has now been compromised and has referred to the copy of the compromise which is annexed at Annexure P-2.

This Court by the order dated 10.05.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 10.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
