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**AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)**

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.202 dated 07.09.2018 registered under Sections 323/324/326/506/34 IPC at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 17.10.2018 the following order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has also suffered 3 injuries as mentioned in the MLR. A quarrel took place over the construction of ramp, which was blocking street as well as the drain. The other co-accused have since been arrested.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Inderjit Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed power of attorney.*

*Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.*

*List on 24.01.2019.”*

Learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana on instructions from ASI Mahender Singh accepts the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 17.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
