The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 225, dated 15.10.2013, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Allegations are that there were various disputes between the complainant and her husband and one of the things which the husband did was to forge an agreement to sell a house belonging to his wife in favour of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the FIR is of 2013 and the petitioner has been in custody for more than one month.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for 1 month and 13 days.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of

the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
