This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.161 dated 11.07.2018 registered at Police Station Daresi, Ludhiana, for the offence under Section 380/34 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued to the State . Meanwhile, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The order dated 17.10.2018, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
