The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for releasing the petitioner on bail pending trial in case FIR No.6 dated 26.03.2018 registered under Sections 21, 29 of NDPS Act (Section 25 of NDPS Act added subsequently) at Police Station State Special Operations Cell, Amritsar, District Intelligence Wing (CID).

Learned State Counsel submits that the Police have got evidence against the petitioner in the form of well connected call details showing the inter-connectivity between the accused, reflecting upon the mixture of Hawala Trade and Drug Trafficking. It is further submitted that the challan has already been filed by the Police and even the FSL report has been received. The case is now fixed before the trial Court for framing of charge for 16.07.2019. It is also submitted that the prosecution shall make earnest effort to complete their evidence as early as possible.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere at this stage and to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, it is further directed that the trial Court shall consider framing charges on the next date of hearing and, thereafter, the prosecution shall complete its evidence, if any, at the earliest possible.
