

Arjun Lal Vs. State of Haryana

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.194 dated 26.3.2015 registered under Sections 304-A IPC and (Section 9 of the Prohibition of Employment of Manual and Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013 added later) at Police Station Bhiwani City, District Bhiwani.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted bail and was regularly appearing before the trial Court. However, due to ill health, as he is suffering from cancer, could not appear before the trial Court, therefore, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled. He was, later on, declared a proclaimed person. Counsel has further stated that another FIR No.574 dated 6.9.2018 was also registered against the petitioner and the petitioner applied for anticipatory bail in the said case as well.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Wazir Singh has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for bail and face the trial, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of ten days from today and on his moving an application for granting him bail, the trial Court will release him on bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction on depositing the costs of Rs.5,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Bhiwani.

The petition stands disposed of.
