This Court has already held in another petition i.e. CRM-M-20457-2019 decided on 06.05.2019 that for enforcement of fundamental right of protection to life and liberty, the remedy is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is not maintainable for protection of fundamental right.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
