This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside order dated 9.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Additional & Sessions Judge, (Family Court), Ambala whereby the application for payment of arrears in instalment was dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record.

The petitioner is not paying the maintenance to his wife and the minor children. A bare perusal of the execution application (Annexure P-1/A) transpires that the arrears of maintenance has been calculated at ₹ 5,50,000/-. Instead of making the payment, the petitioner

moved the present petition for making the payment of arrears of maintenance in instalments. Even to show his bonafide, he is not ready to deposit even a single instalment of arrears of maintenance.

In view of the above and on an independent appraisal of the material available on record, this Court is of the view that the impugned order does not suffer from any illegality, infirmity or irregularity.

Dismissed.
