The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of prohibition to the respondent for violating the directions of superior authorities i.e. DRAT, New Delhi and various High Courts' orders i.e. Annexures P-4 & P-5.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
