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**GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.18 dated 26.1.2019 under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A & 506 IPC, Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula, District Panchkula and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 16.5.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula has been received

wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioners as well as of complainant-Aradhika (through video conferencing) have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant has no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula that the compromise has been arrived at without any kind of undue influence or pressure.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.18 dated 26.1.2019 under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A & 506 IPC, Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula, District Panchkula and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
