GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.202 dated 5.6.2018 registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, wherein offences under Sections 66-C and 66-D of I.T. Act were added later on, and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 17.10.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.)-cum-JMIC, Rewari has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioner/accused Vinit and also of complainant Sukhi Ram have been

recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.)-cum-JMIC, Rewari has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.202 dated 5.6.2018 registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, wherein offences under Sections 66-C and 66-D of I.T. Act were added later on, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
