FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Kulwinder Singh in case bearing FIR No.0116 dated 21.08.2018 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar under Sections 498-A, 323 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 29.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jarnail Singh, Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar who though submits that the petitioner has not cooperated in the investigations however, states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Though on behalf of respondent No.2, Mr.Jagjit Singh, Advocate has sought to oppose grant of bail on the grounds of heinousness of the offence, however, since in the matter only offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 323 IPC have been slapped and thus, there is no occasion for the State to seek unlocking of room of the house. In the light of the same, and in view of the orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
