By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.211 dated 07.08.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' – for short), 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

On 17.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that her husband Savinder Pal Singh got the redemption of land mortgaged with petitioner by impersonating and forging his signatures and transferred the land in her (petitioner's) name. The petitioner has not forged signatures of the complainant or had cheated him in any manner.

Notice of motion for 22.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to

surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of her arrest being required, she shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which she shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to her.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 17.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.10.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
