Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.198 dated 06.07.2018, registered under Sections 452, 354, 323, 324, 506, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.7, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record photostat affidavit of Kunday Singh with regard to compromise.

Learned State counsel has stated that petitioners have joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation. Moreover, no injury has been attributed to the petitioner.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 17.10.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
