Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondents No.4 & 5 for harassing the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.5, who has given a complaint in Police Station Sector-11, Chandigarh.

On 15.01.2019, the following order was passed:

“Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) filed in the Court today, is taken on record and as per this reply, the representation given by the petitioners was marked for inquiry and a report from Police Station Sadar Kharar was sought. In the said inquiry, it is found that the petitioners never came before the Inquiry Officer to get their statements recorded and the respondent has handed over a copy of the order dated 27.08.2018, vide which he and his wife i.e. daughter of the petitioner were given

protection by this Court. It is further stated that no such incident has taken place within jurisdiction of Police Station Sadar Kharar and a similar complaint is pending in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh. In view of the above, no further action is called for against respondents No.1 & 2. Fresh notice be issued to respondent No.4 for 03.05.2019.”

Learned counsel, appearing for U.T., Chandigarh, has submitted that in the inquiry, conducted on the complaint given by the petitioners, it is found that Ravinder Kaur has performed marriage with Gursewak Singh against the wishes of her parents and filed a protection petition bearing CRM-M-37039-2018 before this Court, in which, direction was issued to the police for providing protection to them. Thereafter, both the parties, i.e. Ravinder Kaur, Gursewak Singh and Mukhtiar Singh, father of Ravinder Kaur, started filing complaints each other before the Chandigarh Police as well as Mohali Police and during inquiry, Ravinder Kaur and Gursewak Singh were joined, in which, they have stated that the parents of Ravinder Kaur have taken back their complaint and they do not want to take any action.

In view of the same, no further order is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.
