The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing the FIR No.107 dated 03.09.2009 registered under Sections 153, 186, 328, 427, 447, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sudhar, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana as well as the order dated 07.06.2010 passed by Id. ASJ, Ludhiana, vide which the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is interested in surrendering before the Court, instead of continuing with the challenge to the order of the trial Court declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender. Hence, permission is sought to withdraw the present petition. However, it is submitted that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender without actually effecting any service upon the petitioner and the co-accused have already been acquitted. Therefore, the trial Court be directed to consider the application for regular bail within a specified time.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court

within a period of ten days from today and he moves an application for release on bail, then the trial Court is requested to dispose of the same within a period of ten days.
