Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 28.07.2018 registered under Sections 498A/406/494 of IPC at Police Station Women, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 30.01.2019, petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail in case he surrenders before the trial Court within 7 days from that order and abide by the terms and conditions of Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner and the complainant are staying together as husband and wife at Sri Muktsar Sahib and it is for this reason, the amount of Rs.5,000/- as directed by this Court to be paid to respondent No.2 towards travel expenses, was not paid.

In view of the statement so made by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner and the complainant are staying together as husband and wife at Sri Muktsar Sahib, the order dated 30.01.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice would be given to him.
