Revision against the aforesaid order has already been dismissed. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure as there is statutory bar to the maintainability of second revision.

In the facts of the present case, this Court does not find it to be a fit case to exercise the inherent powers.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
