Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, who are in-laws of deceased Pooja Rani, in FIR No.130 dated 11.08.2018 under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated November 19, 2018 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation. Even otherwise, husband of the deceased Kamal Singh has already been admitted on regular bail by this Court vide order dated 24.01.2019 passed in CRM-M-55221-2018 (Kamal Singh Versus State of Punjab). He refers to the suicide note left by the deceased and contends that there is no allegation that the petitioners ever harassed the deceased or demanded dowry.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurwail Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated November 19, 2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
