Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.154 dated 28.05.2018, registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal, under Sections 148, 323, 324, 325, 452, 506 and 120-B read with Section 149 of the IPC and Section 307 of the IPC added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that injury dangerous to life has been attributed to Mohit as stated by learned State counsel. No specific injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. He is stated to be armed with *danda* and simple injuries are attributed to him and co-accused jointly.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 22.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 22.10.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
