Petitioner has filed this third petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.188 dated 15.11.2017, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana, under Sections 394, 34 and 506 of the IPC, Section 412 of the IPC read with Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 added later on.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the petitioner alongwith other co-accused snatched Fortuner Car from

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the complainant and also fired a shot on the leg of the complainant.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that complainant has already been examined in the trial Court, has not supported the prosecution version and has turned hostile.

The petitioner is in custody since 17.01.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
