Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing Sangam Kumari (detenue), who is daughter of petitioner, from the illegal custody of respondent no.4.

In pursuance of the previous order, the police have filed the report by way of affidavit of Moji Ram, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sarai, Faridabad stating therein that police had visited the place mentioned by the petitioner where the alleged detenue Sangam Kumari was found present. She has made a statement that she has married with Ajay Verma, respondent no.4, with her free will and that she has not been confined in illegal custody.

In view of the above,no further orders are required in this case.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to proceed further with any other remedy available to him in accordance with law.
