After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and she is only a witness to a power of attorney. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not a beneficiary.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and also after considering that the entire case is based upon documents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
