Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.69 dated 06.06.2018 under Sections 384, 506, 420, 120-B, 376 IPC, Sections 7, 13(2) of the P.C. Act, 1988 and Sections 3 & 4 of the SC&ST Act, 1989, registered at Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Harpreet Singh states that trial in the case is at advanced stage, rather, at the verge of conclusion. He further states that out of total 20 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 19 witnesses have been examined so far and the case is now fixed for 02.04.2019.

Faced with the situation that trial in the case is advanced stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition at this stage.
