By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.3 dated 1.1.2017 registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda under Sections 365, 382, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

The learned State counsel upon instruction from ASI Mander Singh, who is present in Court, has informed that the matter has been investigated and upon investigation it has been found that none of the offences has been found to have been committed and the prosecution has already filed a cancellation report in this regard.

Vide order dated 30.11.2017, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Talwandi

Sabo has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Manpreet Singh, Baljeet Singh @ Golu, Gurpreet Singh @ Jaggi and Sukhwinder Singh @ Sonu and also of respondents No.2 and 3, Mangat Raj and Gursewak Singh, have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have not objection in case the FIR is quashed.

It has specifically been opined by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Talwandi Sabo that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid submissions and also in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.3 dated 1.1.2017 registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda under Sections 365, 382, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
