By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the
petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, could not deny the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that all other co-accused, other than one Nirvail Singh against whom 6 other criminal cases are stated to have been pending, have been released on bail, with the petitioner having been in custody for the past one year, with only 2 out of 12 prosecution witnesses having been examined so far. Consequently, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail during the pendency of the trial.

Therefore, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
