The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.99 dated 23.09.2018, under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners were found innocent during investigation. They have been summoned to face trial on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 13.05.2019, had directed petitioner to appear before the trial Court and in the event of their doing so, they were ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners had appeared before the trial Court on 14.05.2019 and has been granted interim bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioners, the order dated 13.05.2019 granting interim bail to petitioners is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
