Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.217 dated 03.10.2017 under Sections 323, 354-B, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties, in view of settlement/compromise dated 23.10.2017 (Annexure P-2).

It being the quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, this Court vide order dated 30.11.2017 directed the parties to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 07.12.2017 to get recorded their statements, in terms of the compromise and the trial Court was further directed to forward the report regarding the genuineness of compromise. Since the parties did not appear before the trial court to get their statements recorded, one more opportunity was granted to them to record their

statements vide order dated 27.07.2018. A report has been received from learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dasuya, to the effect that despite there being the order dated 27.07.2018, parties have not appeared to get their statements recorded. This Court has drawn an inference that the matter has not been compromised between the .

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

However, in case the parties arrive at some compromise, they are at liberty to seek revival of the present petition or file a separate petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
