Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.322 dated 19.09.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.2 in Court today, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as the police has submitted Challan in the case and the petitioner has been granted regular bail by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bhiwani, the present petition no more

survives and is rendered infructuous. He has also produced the certified copy of the order dated 21.02.2019 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bhiwani, whereby petitioner is admitted on bail in the present case, which is taken on record.
