ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.23 dated 23.04.2019 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Purana Shalla, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 19 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from the house of the petitioner. She also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by the order dated 13.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 13.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
