AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 10.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.31174 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“In case, legal notice has been received in the office of concerned authority, it may look into the same and endeavour to decide expeditiously.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Sukhjinder Singh, Accountant, RTO Office, Amritsar, states that delay in compliance of order dated 10.12.2018 occurred as there was no policy for dealing with the claim like that of the petitioner. However, he submits that legal notice would be decided within six

weeks from today and order would be communicated to the petitioner.

In view of above statement, the contempt petition is disposed of.

In case statement made today in the Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
