Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 05.08.2018 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 376 IPC at Police Station Mehtiana, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has solemnized marriage with Harvinder Kaur, the complainant in the case, and they had gone to Singapore also. He referred to the photographs attached with the petition as Annexure P-1. Petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2019. The co-accused Paramjeet Kaur has already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 20.02.2019 passed in **CRM-M-42896-2018** titled as ***Paramjeet Kaur Versus State of Punjab and another.***

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner was earlier married with Tanya from whom he has not taken any divorce, and has gone

Be that as it may, these controversies are to be established during the course of trial. Petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2019 and the trial in the case will take sufficient long time. Thus, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not leave the country and in case, he shall surrender his passport with the trial Court.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.
