Taking note of the fact that parents of petitioner No.1 are residents of State of Haryana, learned counsel appearing for the State of Haryana was requested to assist. The status report by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Faridabad, has been filed along with statements of respondents No.4 and 5 who have stated that petitioner No.1 is major. She has got married with petitioner No.2 and now they do not have any ill-will against them. They have further stated that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners. The petitioners who are not residing in State of Punjab have also suffered statements before the concerned police officer that now they do not have any threat to their life and liberty.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners is not in a

position to deny or accept the stand taken by the respective State counsels.

The petitioners are also not present.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to file a fresh petition, if in future, they apprehend any threat at the hands of respondents.
