Learned counsel for the petitioners is not present even in the second round.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Suba Singh, submits that the petitioners have been declared proclaimed offender and wrong statement has been made that there was a compromise. A specific affidavit has been given by the complainant that there was no compromise.

Case has been adjourned on various occasions after issuing notice of motion on 02.12.2017. It appears that learned counsel for the petitioners is not interested in arguing the case as he is not present in spite of taking up the case twice. Moreover, the petitioners have already been declared proclaimed offender and they do not deserve concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.

However, in case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court and move application for bail within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the trial Court is directed to consider the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.
