The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.286, dated 18.7.2017, registered under Sections 365, 328, 376-D, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 7, 8, 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, at Police Station Butana, District Karnal.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year and more than 9 months and the matter is now fixed for evidence. The main accused Daljeet Singh is still in jail.

Learned AAG Haryana has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular

bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
