**INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.57 dated 21.01.2014, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, under Sections 302, 449 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations in the FIR, Neeraj Punia fired a shot upon Amit which landed on his right hand and

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he again fired which hit to the temple of Amit and thereafter, Brij Punia also fired shots from his weapon. The present petitioner is not named in the FIR. No injury is attributed to him. As per the FIR, the main accused are Neeraj Punia and Brij Punia.

The petitioner has been in custody since 17.09.2014. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of case keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case especially the fact that he is not named in the FIR and no injury is attributed to him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
