MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.115 dated 04.04.2018 registered under Sections 332, 353, 342, 186, 307, 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Badhra, District Charkhi Dadri.

On 22.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the FIR or there is any evidence with the police about his involvement in the incident dated 04.04.2018 in which the police party was allegedly attacked while attempting to get release Ajit son of Mahender, who was caught with liquor and the confiscated liquor was taken away.

Notice of motion for 24.01.2019.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall

abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 22.10.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Harish Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 22.10.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
