Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate directions for constituting Special Investigation Team (SIT) comprising of higher ranking police officers outside District Tarn Taran to investigate case FIR No.78 dated 06.11.2014, under Sections 307, 427, 379, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Khemkaran, District Tarn Taran.

In response to the petition, status report by way of affidavit of Harpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Valtaha Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran, was filed, wherein the steps taken

during the investigation were highlighted.

Today learned State counsel on instructions from HC Balwinder Singh has apprised the Court that after completion of investigation, cancellation report dated 02.3.2018 was submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that the said cancellation report has already been rejected by the trial Court and further investigation has been ordered.

Considering the above stage of the investigation and intervention of the learned Magistrate, this Court is not inclined to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at this stage.

The petition is dismissed.
