However, an affidavit of Sh. Jagat Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narwana, has been filed in Court today by the learned State counsel, stating to the effect that as per the statement recorded of the brother of the complainant, under Section 161 of the Cr.P.C., money was given by him and his brother-in-law at a particular place.

The affidavit is taken on record.

Without making any comment on the merits of the case for or against the petitioner in each of the petitions, the allegation being that the petitioner had taken money from the complainant to get him recruited as a Constable in the Haryana Police, the fact of the matter being that the complainant himself is no longer interested in pursuing the case, and learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submitting that the petitioner in each of the petitions has joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required presently, these petitions are allowed, and the orders granting interim bail to the petitioner in each of the petitions are made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.
