Petitioner seeks quashing of transfer order dated 04.05.2019 (Annexure P4) primarily on the ground that he is suffering from a cardiac disease, as per certificate dated 17.09.2016 (Annexure P1).

2. Perusal of above certificate shows that the same has been issued by Maternity Hospital.

3. Other grounds raised in the present writ petition need not to be gone into, as the transfer is a matter of administrative exigency. Even otherwise, after a perusal of certificate issued by the Cardiologist, who has diagnosed the petitioner in the maternity hospital, I am of the opinion that the aliment certified, as per the medical certificate, does not warrant any interference in the transfer.

4. No ground is made out to interfere in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
