FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Anil Malhotra in case bearing FIR No.180 dated 09.09.2018 registered at Police Station Sector 49, Chandigarh under Sections 323, 354, 354-B, 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 22.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI (Ms.) Sarabjit Kaur, Police Station Sector 49, Chandigarh who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that she has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order

dated 22.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, the petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
