Challenge in the instant writ petition is to the Memo dated 01.04.2019 (Annexure P-7) issued by the Assistant Executive Engineer Sahnewal under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and in terms of which a final assessment for unauthorized use of electricity has been made and the petitioner has been made liable to deposit the final assessed charges of Rs.37,10,012/-.

During the course of arguments, counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that the petitioner has a remedy of filing of an appeal to the Appellate Authority notified by the Government of Punjab i.e. the Divisional Commissioner concerned against the impugned Memo at Annexure P-7.

In view of the above, this Court declines to interfere in the matter and the writ petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to avail of the remedy of appeal.
